July 20th | Exodus 6-15

Read Exodus 5:22 - 6:9

- Why were the people's spirits broken?

- What is God setting up to happen - that is, how does He intend for the Exodus to happen?

Read Exodus 6:28 - 7:7

- Why would God harden Pharaoh's heart?

- What was Moses' argument against going to Pharaoh? God's response?

Reference Exodus 7 - 10

- List the first 9 plagues and their effects on the nation of Egypt.

For instance, when the Nile turned to blood in the first plague, what happened to the fish? What would this mean for folks?

- Why would God give the first 9 plagues?

This about Pharaoh's heart & God's character

Reference Chapter 12

- What are the instructions for protection from the 10th plague?

Read Exodus 12:29 - 32

- Reflect on Pharaoh using God's name.
- Reflect on Pharaoh asking to be blessed.
- Why is Pharaoh so affected by this plague?

Read Exodus 12:37-38

- How many people were in the exodus?
- What else went out with the people? Reflect on the logistics!

Read Exodus 13:17-22

- Why did God choose the direction of the Exodus?
- Why did God appear in cloud and fire?

Reference Chapter 14

- Why does God have the people make camp?
- What do the people say when they see the Egyptians coming?
- How did God prevent the Egyptians from catching up to the Israelites?

Read Exodus 15:22-27

- What is the next complaint by the Israelites?
- How does God respond?
