Where was Paul & why was this a huge deal?

What tactics does Paul use to teach and proclaim?

How can you do this in your own life of witness?

Read Romans 12:9-21

What does it mean for Paul to be writing these words reflecting on his previous life?

How can you use these verses to guide you today and in the future?
